The black male subject was seen in the area by officers and after a short foot chase the subject was apprehended and arrested.

Summary of Investigation, Officer's Opinion, Background to case, etc.

I received a call to back up Officer Kuykendall on a possible rape at [REDACTED]. Dispatcher put a description out over the air saying the subject involved was a black male in a blue coat. As I was enroute to the complainant's apartment, driving directly behind Officer Kuykendall, north on North 9th from Colcord, I saw a black male wearing a blue coat and carrying a portable radio, walk west across N. 9th Street from near where the complainant's apartment was located. Officer Kuykendall and myself then stopped this black male at the corner of N. 9th & Indiana. As Officer Kuykendall was talking with the black male subject and as Officer Kuykendall was patting him down for weapons the black male subject started to run northwest through the projects located just west on N. 9th Street. The black male subject ran in a northwesternly direction toward N. 10th Street and Tennessee. Officer Kuykendall immediately pursued the black male subject between the apartments while I ran between another set of apartments to try to see what way they would run. As I was running west around the apartments

I saw the black male subject, with Officer Kuykendall in pursuit, run from around the far end of the apartment complex west across N. 10th Street then into a wooded area at the southwest corner of North 10th & Tennessee. I then ran to the south side of the wooded area to block off any escape route that the black male subject might take. As I was standing along side the south side of the wooded area I heard someone running through the bushes towards me. I then saw a flashlight shine from across the north side of the wooded area and Officer Kuykendall then called out to me to see if I had the south side blocked off. After yelling to Officer Kuykendall that I was covering the south side I turned my flashlight toward the north and I saw a black male subject trying to run through the thick bush toward me. I yelled for him to come out and when I did he turned and started to run north through the bushes toward where Officer Kuykendall was at. I then heard Officer Kuykendall yell at the black male subject to stop where he was at and then Officer Kuykendall informed dispatcher that he did have the black male subject in custody. At that time I left the wooded area and returned to N. 9th and Indiana to retrieve the subject's radio that he had left on top of Officer Kuykendall's patrol car and to standby and wait for Officer Kuykendall to come back to his vehicle. When Officer Kuykendall returned to his patrol car I drove across the street where I went to talk with the complainant. I along with Sgt. Hassell and Sgt. Mayfield entered the complainant's apartment where I saw a black female sitting and crying on the couch and who was later identified as the victim. [REDACTED] was very upset and she could not tell me what had happened without becoming hysterical. I attempted to find out the description on the subject and at this time I was only able to find out that the subject was a black male about 20, clean shaven, wearing a cap with white initials of "CT" on the front of it. He was also wearing a blue trench coat. At this time because of the [REDACTED] I was unable to get a thorough idea of what actually took place. I did get a few facts from [REDACTED] but I'm unable to tell at this time the time and sequence of events that took place in her home. [REDACTED] did tell me that she was sleeping in her bed when she was awakened by her bedroom light coming on. She said that when she opened her eyes she saw a black male subject standing over her pulling on her bedsheets. The black male subject told [REDACTED] not to scream or he would kill her and her two children. He at that time put his hand in his pocket as though he had a weapon inside however [REDACTED] told me that she never did see a weapon. She told me that the black male subject told her to take her panties off and for her

not to look at him. She told me she then noticed that he had a cap on with white letters of "CT" on the front of it. She told me that he made her have sex with him and then wanted her money. She said that he went through her purse taking the money out of it and then he threw her billfold on the floor next to the bed. [REDACTED] said that he went to her daughters bedroom where he opened their doors and looked in. She said that he then walked toward the living room where she thought that he had left her apartment. She told me that she got up out of the bed and walked out into the living room where she found her front door open. She said that she closed it and locked it at that time. She also saw that her kitchen window was open and the screen was missing off it. She said that she went over to the kitchen window and closed it at that time.

I also talked to her daughters [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who were in their bedroom sleeping when the rape took place. Both [REDACTED] told me that they did not hear anything at all. [REDACTED] told me that she heard her mother crying in the living room and when she went to find out what was going on her mother told her what had happened.

[REDACTED] was able to show me where the rape took place. She took me in her bedroom where she showed me her bed and where her purse and wallet were left by the black male subject. She also showed me the kitchen window which was now closed. I saw [REDACTED] purse lying near the foot of her bed with a personalized book and glasses case lying near it on the bed. I also saw a billfold lying on the floor near the night stand and just east of the bed. I also saw miscellaneous papers on the night stand which were apparently from [REDACTED] purse. I also saw a blue button lying on the floor near the billfold. [REDACTED] at this time told me that the subject had taken her money and that he had also taken her brown leather cigarette case containing Kool Filter Longs. I also was told by [REDACTED] that two other blue buttons were left by the subject, one on the bed and one lying on the floor near the bed.

[REDACTED] was then taken to Providence Hospital by her sister [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] where she was examined by the doctor on duty. Duty Attorney Brad Cates was contacted and he did authorize a rape exam to be preformed on the complainant.
